Brenda McClure

Cultured and sophisticated, member Brenda Gravelle McClure proclaims she didn't wear a skirt until she was 13 years old. Brenda was raised in the beautiful countryside of St. Thomas, Ontario, the daughter of a French father who immigrated to Canada when he was 9. She lived with her grandparents and mother across the road from her Great Grandparent's farm, surrounded by her brother, male cousins and neighboring boys.

Her life took a definitive turn at the age of 19 when she flew to Miami to visit friends. Departing the all-too-familiar snow-covered March landscape of Canada, she stepped off the plane to blue sky, fluffy clouds and a warm breeze and decided then and there she was moving to Florida! Following that trip, she flew home, handed in her resignation at work and immediately applied for her green card. She was a young woman on a mission. She moved to Windsor, Ontario a neighboring town of Detroit and took the daily bus across the border until she landed a bank job in the US, in order to be sponsored for her green card. She later moved to Miami in fulfillment of her original plan.



She met her first husband while visiting relatives in Tampa and 4 years later, with their son Michael Craig Williams in tow, lived in Florida, Kansas, Alabama, Massachusetts, and New York. Finally, in 1980 they moved back to Florida and bought a home in Sweetwater. When this stay-at-home mom became an empty-nester, she worked as a tour guide for 8 years hosting guests visiting Disney, the Cape and Busch Gardens, and in 1996 she met her husband Leonard while working as a bookkeeper. (She adores math to this day.) Five years later, she and Leonard were married and she finally got her citizenship around the same time, inspired to vote in the next election. In 2013, she retired from real estate after 10 years.

Brenda's son Craig, stepson, and step grandson, live nearby. She has been a Heathrow resident since 1994 and an HWC member for many years, served on the HWC social committee, in Dine-around and a bridge club. She played tennis for 30 years, loves gardening, Bible study, the beach and cruises. She and Leonard are taking their whole blended family on a cruise for the second time, this spring. She detests shopping for herself - possibly a holdover from her younger years as a country girl...? Brenda currently serves on several Heathrow Community committees, keeping her super busy. She and Leonard have a lovely waterfront home in Heron Ridge, adorned with numerous art pieces bought on past cruises.
