## SPOTLIGHT

### *April Darrow*

April Darrow, our Spotlight featured member, grew up in Mt. Clemens, Michigan, along with one younger sister. Her father worked in construction while her Mom stayed at home with the girls for 14 years, then got her degrees and had a career at General Motors. Her Mom's drive must have influenced April as she says, "I am very competitive!" In fact, she has been a runner for over 34 years, starting in the 8<sup>th</sup> grade. As a high school freshman, she discovered cross county running and found her niche. While in her teens, April moved with her Dad to Georgia to escape the cold in MI.

She ran all four years in High School, and through the support of great coaching and amazing teammates, she was offered running scholarships at two schools. After a brief stop at Georgia Southern (her first experience with roommates!), she ran for Kennesaw State University. She says, "Two experiences I'll never forget are participating in the NAIA National Meet in 1992 and being named to the Peach Belt All Conference team in Women's Cross Country in 1994." She earned her degree in Marketing/Sales and, following college, she continued her amateur running career by turning to road racing.

During her career, April was in sales management for a number of companies leasing and managing apartments. In the mid-late 1990s, she was assigned several territories in Florida and lived in four cities in 2 years! Then she sold real estate for a while and also worked at a couple of accounting firms. Once she arrived in Central Florida, she continued her sales career working for a major kitchen cabinet manufacturer. She enjoys the even warmer weather here, except while running during the hot and humid summers.

She met her husband, Bob, a Financial services professional, through running and they married in 2004, later moving into Alaqu Lakes. They have four fur babies-3 dogs and one cat. April says she has always loved doing charity work, whether to benefit animals or children. She has supported *Pet Rescue by Judy* and has helped find homes for many dogs and cats over the last seven years, including hers.

In 2012, after 9 years of selling cabinets, April took some time off and began following her two biggest passions, at first working for a local veterinarian, and then buying a specialty running store in Lake Mary—*Front Running Sports*. She says she is very hands-on with the business which sells shoes for walking and running, as well as apparel and accessories. The store is best known for the comprehensive fitting process, ensuring that each customer is placed in the most appropriate shoe. She says, "It is so rewarding to combine my passion for fitness with an active interest in what has become a very vibrant business community." One popular accessory somewhat unique to her store are leashes designed to allow customers to safely run with their dogs. Other tasks that fall under Public Relations include but are not limited to: writing articles for the Heathrow Living Magazine and member Spotlight articles.

**Social:** responsible for organizing social activities and events for HWC members and when appropriate for their adult guests as well. Some activities include: Bridge, Bunco, Dine Around, Book Club, Progressive Dinner, Happy Hour Social and much, much more.

**Membership:** responsible for answering questions from prospective members about the club and registering new members at the luncheons.

**Ways & Means:** responsible for planning and implementing the fundraising efforts of the club, including Club Sponsorships. Members are encouraged to participate in a variety of activities throughout the year; i.e. Annual Golf Tournament, Bake Sale, Yard Sale, Purse Auction, Major Spring Benefit and more.
