*The NEWZ Spotlight feature began in 1991.

*Early on, The NEWZ served as a profit center, focusing mostly on ads for small businesses in the local area. *New area residents were invited to a get-together by the HWC BOD to learn more about the Club and potentially join.

*The May installation of officers was a big deal and took place in the evening rather than at the luncheon.

*Raffles to raise money for the Club go back to the 90s.

*Fundraisers during this time were most often to raise money for a specific charity.

*The first "Simply Delicious" cookbook was published in Oct. 1997 and cost \$8. An apron was also available for \$12.

*The first HWC Book Club met on September 15, 1996






