issues.

Growing up in New Rochelle, NY, a suburb of Manhattan, her mother owned a book and school supplies store near the high school and her father was a sales executive for a children's wear company. Andi has two younger brothers. She and her husband, Jim, spend several months each year returning to the NYC area to see their family and friends.

Andi graduated from New Rochelle High School and the University of Tennessee (with an undergraduate degree in Journalism and a master's degree in Counseling). "I wanted to be a sportswriter but, in those days, women weren't welcome in that profession, so I taught school for three years." She then spent the next 25-years as a school guidance counselor in the South Bronx: "Many days were peaceful dealing with the problems of the kids, but it was the most rewarding thing I have ever done."

After witnessing the Twin Towers coming down on 9/11, she had a lot of students whose family members worked at the restaurant, Windows on the World. They Andi met her ex-husband in Tennessee and together they had three children – two boys and one girl. They eventually divorced and twenty years ago, she married Jim McNally. "We have four amazing grandsons, three in New York and one in Lake Mary" she says. They retired nine years ago and moved to Lake Forest in Sanford. Jim is a golfer and wanted the warm weather, but Andi is emphatic that she would have continued working in the career that she loved.

She joined HWC to participate in the charity initiatives and to meet new people. She was the Chairperson for Charitable Endeavors-CE for two years. She proudly says, "We accomplished two important things – a library at the Boys and Girls Club and the children's waiting room at the Juvenile Justice Center." Andi is currently on the CE committee, participating in numerous activities including becoming a Guardian ad Litem, a volunteer children's advocate




