Pam Drew

Traveling to every continent, except Antarctica, for pleasure and work has given HWC member Pam Drew an intense appreciation for the different cultures - the people, the lifestyle, the food, and the languages. She says "Living in Ethiopia for fifteen months (while her former husband worked for Harris Corp.) was a fascinating experience. I realized how lucky we are to live in the USA. I saw poverty, illness, and malnutrition, but yet the people were the most beautiful, warm and amazingly content."

Pam, the mother of Gainesville, FL resident David, his wife Amy, and their 18 year old son, Ryan, was born in Texas and moved to Melbourne, Florida at age 13. After living in the Springs in Longwood in the 1970s, she spent thirty years in Cupertino, California as a human resources professional for high tech companies. Her career even took her to India annually. "We had 600 employees there who were so interesting and so much fun." She recounts the time the company's HR team all went to see a movie together, based on a mutually enjoyable book.



She retired to Fountain Parke in Lake Mary in 2010 with her now 16-yr. old cat Bandit. Recalling his early days in Florida creates much laughter, "He didn't like our flight, then he would only befriend those who were from California. Eventually he warmed up to people in this area and now he even accepts dogs."

Retirement has created an opportunity for her to explore a wide variety of interests. Pam, a member of the Heathrow and Legacy Golf Clubs, plays the game each Thursday. "I am almost as busy now as when I worked," she reflects. She played duplicate bridge many years ago and has recently begun to play again two to three times a month at the North Orlando Bridge Club.

"Doing whatever needs to be done," is her mantra as she volunteers weekly in the kindergarten class at Bentley Elementary in Sanford. For the past eighteen months, Pam has participated in a variety of classroom activities and affectionately describes the environment as filled with "cute and sweet" children.

Travel is still high on her list of interests as she recently traveled back to the San Francisco area to visit friends and take a cruise along the West Coast down to Mexico. Pam joined the Heathrow Women's Club to meet other active women and is eager to be more involved in the group's volunteer initiatives as her time permits.

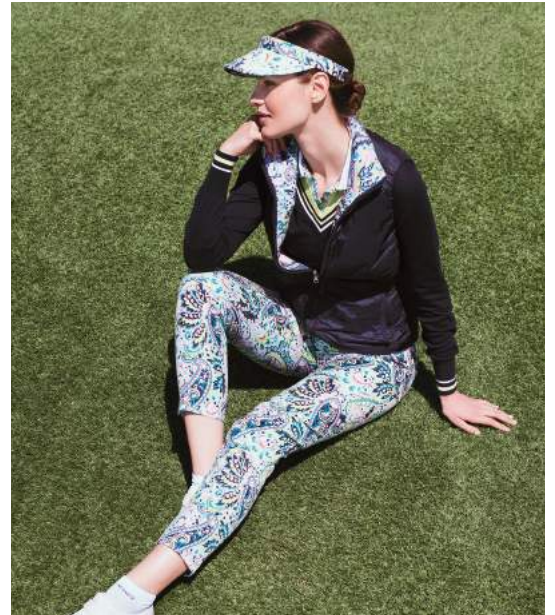

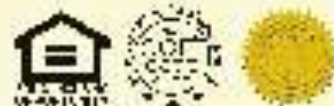
