### Spotlight Janet Roberts by Kerrianne Arnold

anet Roberts, a new member this year, was born in Dallas, TX, and attended the University of Texas in Austin, receiving her B.A. in economics.



She worked 10 years in computer mainframe hardware and software as a support analyst and salesperson. Years later, she attended the University of Houston Law Center and received her J.D. degree. She worked in a Dallas law firm practicing product liability law for 3 years before starting her private law practice in Fort Lauderdale where she practiced product liability, homeowner's association law, and some business law for 10 years. She later became a prosecutor with the State Attorney's Office in Broward County for almost 20 years.

For many years, Jane was on the Board of Directors of her homeowner's association including serving as President. This Board performed its own management and accounting functions and she authored and filed many amendments to their bylaws. After retiring from the State Attorney's Office in Fort Lauderdale, she moved to Heathrow and earned her real estate license. Now, she is an independent real estate agent with Weichert Realty – Hallmark properties and still practices law under her own company. Janet says, "I love working."

Janet's dad, a mechanical engineer, and surveyor was the

head of the surveying department in Dallas County, TX for many years. He also held a 3rd-degree black belt in Tae Kwan Do karate, was a karate instructor for the Ye Mo Ahn family, who played a prominent role in U.S.karate, and taught his six daughters karate. They attended classes with the Ahn family and Allen Steen schools. Her mom, a hairstylist in Dallas whose clientele included many of Dallas' socialites, was also active in her church and was a member of multiple Dallas charitable and social clubs. Janet says, "Both of my parents were very kind and loving, but mom was the mother that I feel so lucky to have had. I never heard her talk bad of anyone and she helped so many people. Everyone loved her. She was that kind of a person."

Janet is the 4th sister of 6 sisters and all her sisters live in either Dallas or Austin. Four of her sisters are lawyers, one is a paralegal, and her other sister, who holds a Masters in mathematics and electrical engineering, owns her own international computer company. In addition, her sister who is a

paralegal was a Dallas Cowboys cheerleader and was in the 70s movie "Dallas Cowboy Cheerleaders."

Janet has been married to her husband, Tom, for 42 years. "Tom is my best friend and I love him dearly, with all my heart. He is a very kind, sweet, and smart man, too." Tom, now retired, has worked in the sensor automation industry as a sales engineer. His sold sensor hardware company and software automate and manage to productions for companies like Budweiser and Coca-Cola.

Janet enjoys drawing, cooking, playing the piano, and gardening. She says she is not good at any of those things, but they bring her immense joy. Active in sports throughout her life, she competed in the AAU and won several multi-state AAU competitions for high jumping in high school. She won a meet to go to the U.S. Olympic tryouts but was disqualified because she was a few months short of the minimum age requirement. This was a huge disappointment to her and she stopped competing after that.

Tom and Janet moved to Heathrow to escape the hurricanes in Fort Lauderdale. They lived on a canal that was a short walk from the beach. Every hurricane was a nailbiter. Hurricane Andrew hit just one month after they moved to Fort Lauderdale. As they got older, the stress of preparing for a hurricane and fearing a direct hit just got too much. They also wanted a change in scenery and were drawn to beautiful Heathrow after their search took two years of looking at thousands of homes online and dragging her "poor" husband all over Florida on weekends. She even watched the home she now lives in for 8 months, as the price dropped steadily. Finally, on the last price drop of \$50,000, which she saw posted at midnight, she had her husband agree to get up at 3:00 a.m. to drive to be the first to see the home. "We bought the home that day!" Janet says her husband says, "Happy Wife, Happy Life." And she adds, "I just love that saying!!!!"

Janet knew no one when she moved here and began to crave camaraderie and wanted to get to know other ladies in her community. She was impressed with the tone, content, and consistency of the articles in Heathrow Living magazine and decided to join HWC. Janet says, "I have met some wonderful women, all very accomplished. I am so amazed and grateful to have such wonderful role models and such kind women in my life. HWC really is integral to my happiness. The women and their hearts are amazing. The world can be so hard and evil, too, but HWC exemplifies the very good in this world. Nice that it is in my own backyard." She cannot wait for the pandemic to lift so she can meet some more kind, wonderful women in HWC.

#### Safe House

- No current activities this month, although SafeHouse CEO, Jeanne Gold, provided a video at the April member Zoom meeting highlighting plans for renovations. Further, they have agreed for our members to provide breakfast, candy, and flowers to the women for Mother's Day.
- Sponsor Oakmonte Village has offered to provide breakfast for this event. Cyndy Bloch has agreed to be the committee's coordinator for SafeHouse volunteer activities for the next year.

# The Foundation for Seminole County Public Schools

- Jean Vansmith, Executive Director for the Foundation, provided a video shared at the member Zoom meeting on April 13th with updates on their program. The Take Stock in Children Graduation will be held on Thursday, May 6th at the Educational Support Center at 400 E. Lake Mary Boulevard in Sanford from 6-8 pm.
