SPOTLIGHT *Shelley Pynn*

Unlike many of the ladies in our club, Shelley Pynn grew up here in Central Florida. She attended local colleges receiving an Associate's Degree from Seminole State and a Bachelor's Degree from the University of Central Florida. Her Liberal Arts Degree allowed her to combine business and her love of the arts. She met her husband, Roger, while in college and they will celebrate 42 years of marriage this November. She says, "I guess we're both driven as entrepreneurs." Roger built one of Florida's most recognized public relations firms, *Curley & Pynn Public Relations & Marketing Communications*. Although they have no children, they feel like their niece and nephew, who live in Central Florida, are theirs.

Shelley is one of those very fortunate people who found her passion right after college. She sent her resume' in response to one ad by a travel agency—and Park Avenue Travel hired her. She later helped the owner start a subsidiary to market group travel and they named it The Travel Group. Working with her mentor, they built The Travel Group together until she was ready to retire and Shelley has owned it since 1989.

She has spent over 40 years working in a profession she loves. Shelley says her career "has let me see the world and share it with others." Her job has taken her on camel rides and into the depths of the pyramids in Egypt, for donkey rides up the mountain to the top of Santorini in Greece, for walks along the Great Wall of China, up close to Alaskan glaciers as huge chunks of ice crash into the Pacific and for a train ride up the Matterhorn in Switzerland.

Shelley began giving back early. Both she and Roger were in Collegiate Civitan, a service club sponsored by Civitan International and they just loved being involved in service projects and helping others. She's still involved with Civitan as a member of the Frontier Civitan Club, which is the first all-woman's Civitan Club. Also, she is a long-time member of the UCF Town and Gown Council who work to advance UCF's role in the region. The Pynns moved to Heathrow in 1989, first to Regency Green and now the Bridgewater Club, and Shelley joined Heathrow Women's Club around that time. Shelley says she's made many friends in the club. The annual galas have always been a lot of fun because she gets to bring Roger and she especially likes the silent auction. And, although she indicates that it doesn't do much for her diet, the bake sale is wonderful. Currently, Shelley is a co-chair of the Ways & Means Committee, focusing on coordinating our upcoming Golf Tournament and our annual Spring Gala.

She indicates that she is fortunate in that her career is really her hobby. She says, "After all, who doesn't love to travel?" On the Pynn's very first trip together they toured Italy--enjoying the entire experience--art, architecture, history, food, and language. They have enjoyed many cruises and tours to Europe, the Orient, Alaska, Caribbean, plus they love River cruising- along the Danube, or in Burgundy and Provence. Closer to home, they love boating and her eponymously named boat - The SeaShelley - has introduced them to a whole new world of fun on the water.

It turns out that Shelley and I have much in common, as I too answered an ad while in college and started my career in travel. Shelley and I spent a wonderful time at Panera Bread Company sharing travel stories and marveling at the changes we have experienced in our industry. Shelley mentioned that she is known as "Shopping Shelley" and has photos of herself shopping around the world. She once was in Rome for a travel conference and went to St. Peter's Square and the Pope was on his balcony blessing the crowd! And, I learned that one thing we have in common is that we both got lost in Hong Kong. That is a particularly interesting feat since all the street signs are in English!

Shelley shared that the travel industry has gone through many changes and although many people think travel agents were "victims" of the growth of the Internet, the truth is that our business just continues to grow because people want advice based on experience and knowledge of destinations. And, I totally agree.

Shelley was one of the first agency owners to recognize that the future wasn't in bricks and mortar travel agencies and she moved her business home in 1999. Finance: responsible for staffing the registration table at our luncheon.

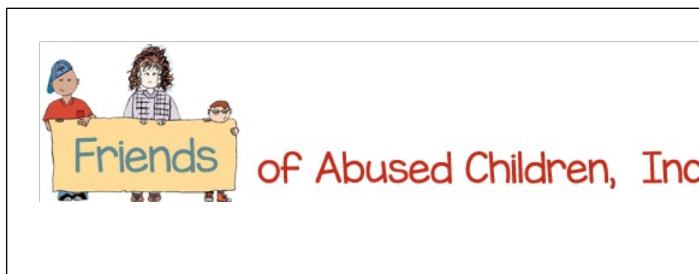

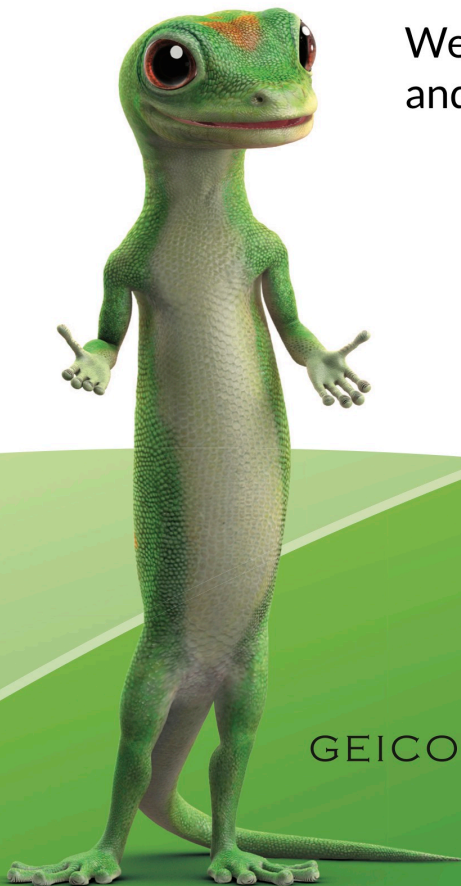
