Cynthia Lebowitz

Cynthia Bryan is the only daughter of a New York City policeman and Harlem beautician mother, a go-to for the likes of many stars in Harlem who were also entertained in their own Bronx home. The Bronx had vast farmland during her youth, with horses and a sundry of animals, she recalls. Cynthia ended up going to Catholic school when an opening arose before an opening to the Jewish school! Oy vey...the kismet! In high school, she played clarinet in the school's marching band and later embraced the bassoon and oboe, as well.



Her first job was at a "pocketbook" store as we in the Northeast called our handbags back then, and later worked several part-time jobs throughout her years at Hunter College in Manhattan. She was a biology major and clinical lab science student who once considered of a career in forensic medicine, but her life's work in computers would supplant that idea, starting with a master's degree at Rutgers in health information systems. She was an early internet user in 1980, albeit antiquated by today's standards. At a convention in Columbus, Ohio attended by early internet users, the advent of digitalized photos was the new buzz.
