Charitable Endeavors

typically offers volunteer activities for our charities and monitors their needs and challenges. Despite the pandemic curbing our events for the past 18 months, we continue to enjoy a large membership of 55 people. We are grateful for the interest and participation.

The committee met on Monday, July 26th, under the leadership of Lee Granger, in the absence of Leslie Guerra-Chair, at the Sawyer Lake Clubhouse with 17 members in attendance. The meeting was held in conjunction with the annual school supplies drive that HWC conducts for the Seminole County Friends of Abused Children. Jim Hill, the President, spoke and picked up the generous donations – 7 full boxes, 11 full sacks, and roughly \$500 in contributions.



Summaries of each charity's activities were given by liaisons or their representatives and are below.

SafeHouse – (Cyndy Bloch liaison)

No outside third parties are allowed on the premises due to COVID. There will be no Walk on Water 5K.

They are looking for party supplies for events they are holding with the residents.

SafeHouse will let us know when we may resume in-person activities – a night of beauty, clothes closet, cooking, and other interactions with children/women.

Foundation for Seminole County Public Schools – (Andi McNally liaison)

They are asking for continued support for the monthly food drive for school pantries (Pine Crest Elementary School in Sanford), Secret Santa, and the Take Stock in Children graduation event. Mentoring opportunities are available. See Andi for details.

Seminole County Friends of Abused Children

Jim reported that the number of families served is increasing again. They need children's clothing, and this could be done

through donations with Target or Wal-Mart gift cards.

Cherie Foutz has volunteered to be the liaison for this organization for the 2021-22 year. Thanks, Cherie!

The Boys and Girls Club – (Lynn Daniel liaison)

We continue the monthly birthday cupcakes/cards drop-offs for the children and in-person may resume soon.

The club is currently at about 50%. We will be notified when we are able to provide more hands-on activities for the children. Meanwhile, please let Lynn know if you can volunteer for the monthly birthday parties. We have one volunteer for September and three for October.

Finally, our favorite *Santa's helpers, Pat Darrah and Connie McDonald are already preparing for the Secret Santa program* which will be held virtually and in-person this year. More details to follow! Look for that

The HWCC Board met on Tuesday, July 27th, and voted to give \$500 each to SafeHouse, the Foundation for Seminole County Public Schools, and The Boys and Girls Club to kick off the school year for supplies.




