
Ways and Means

Here are the steps to bid:

- Step #1 You will receive a text prior to the event on March 6, letting you know the auction is open and including a link to the site.
- Step #2 Click on the link. It will open a web page with the auction page. Just scroll down to see what it is available and bid on the one(s) you want.
- Step #3 The only part of this that may not be intuitive, is that you must make a bid and checkout. That confirms that if you are the highest bidder. If you choose "checkout later" you could be overbid before you submit your first bid.

A handout will be available at the event with additional information about the bidding process. Helpers will be available.


